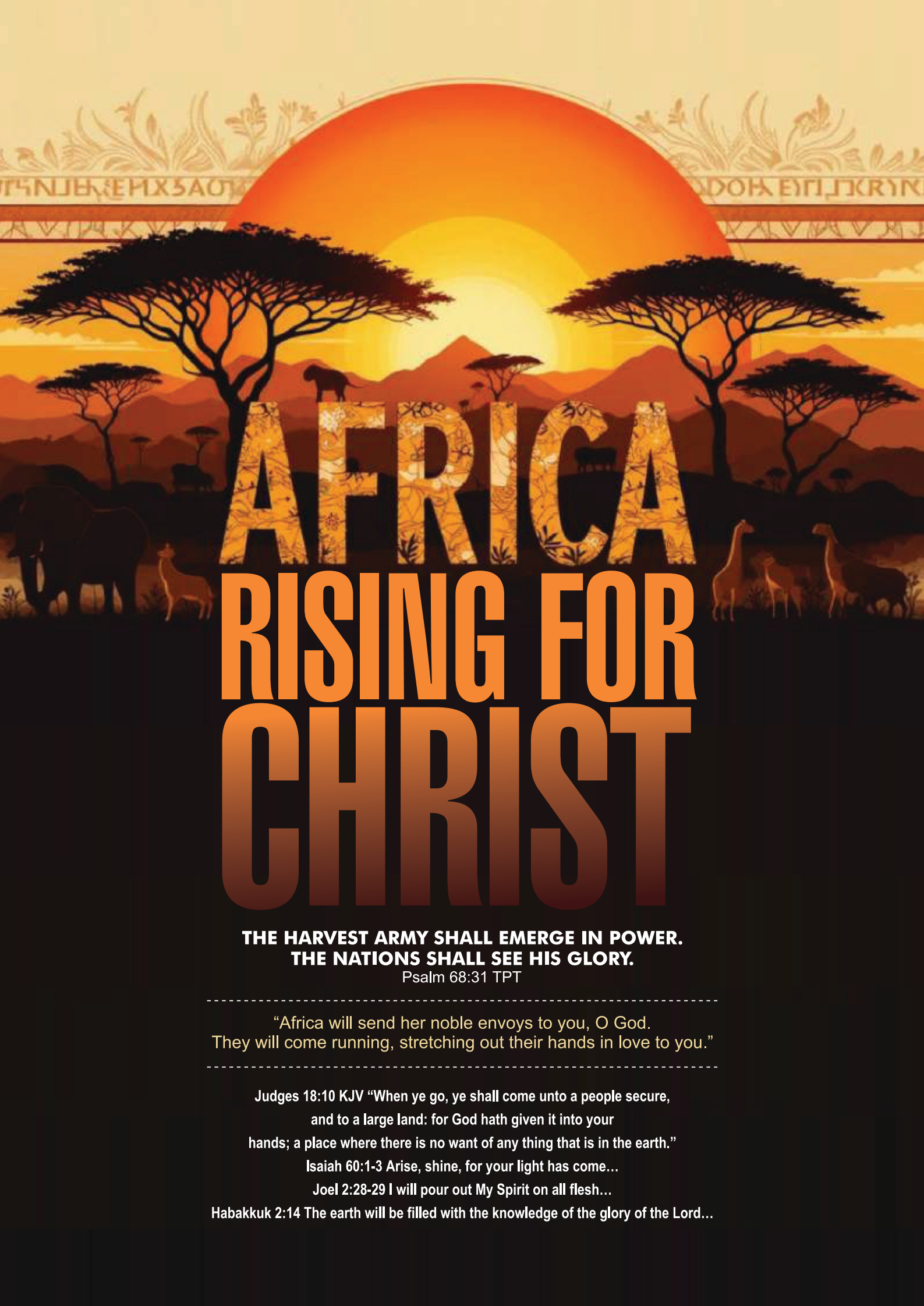

What is SAOC?

ABOUT SALEM AFRICA **OUTPOURING CONFERENCE**

The Salem Africa Outpouring Conference (SAOC) is a prophetic gathering birthed from a divine vision to ignite revival, stir up miracles, equip leaders, mobilise the youth, advance missions, and transform the marketplace across the African continent and beyond. ORIGIN OF THE VISION

The seeds of SAOC can be traced back to earlier outpouring gatherings within the Salem family, from Port Harcourt, to Lagos, Europe, Abuja and Ghana. In Lagos, it ran with the name-Achievers International Conference.

These events demonstrated God's heart for revival in Salem Family Worldwide. Under the Apostolic and patriarchal leadership of Archbishop Sam Amaga and the wider Salem International Christian Centre (Foundation Faith Church), the vision has expanded to a full African continental awakening. The elevation of Bishop Enobong Etteh as the Continental Bishop of Africa marked a pivotal shift, entrusting him to lead the African Continental Missions Council with driving the Africa Rising for Christ Project (The ARC Project)—a strategic initiative to plant churches, raise leaders, and accelerate covenant destinies continent-wide. SAOC 2026 represents the culmination and elevation of this journey: an Africa-wide outpouring designed to accelerate the occupying and sending role of the continent.

He is an author and has published two books. He is married to Rev Esther and they are blessed with 3 children.

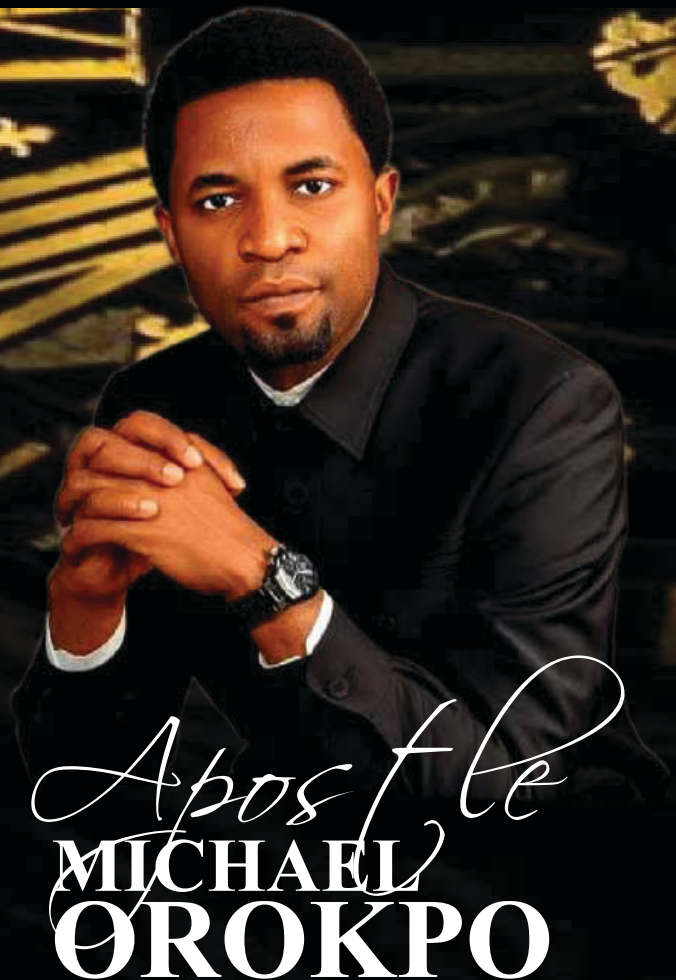

He is married to **Rev. (Mrs.) Margaret Ajuma Ibenu**. They have four children:

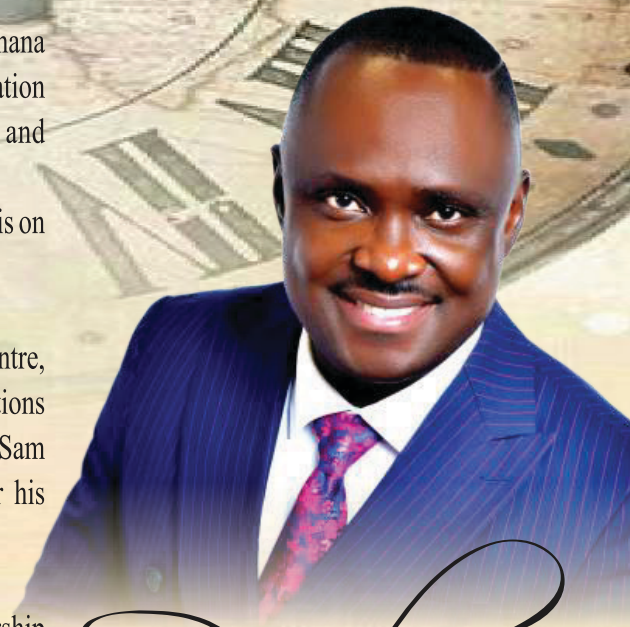

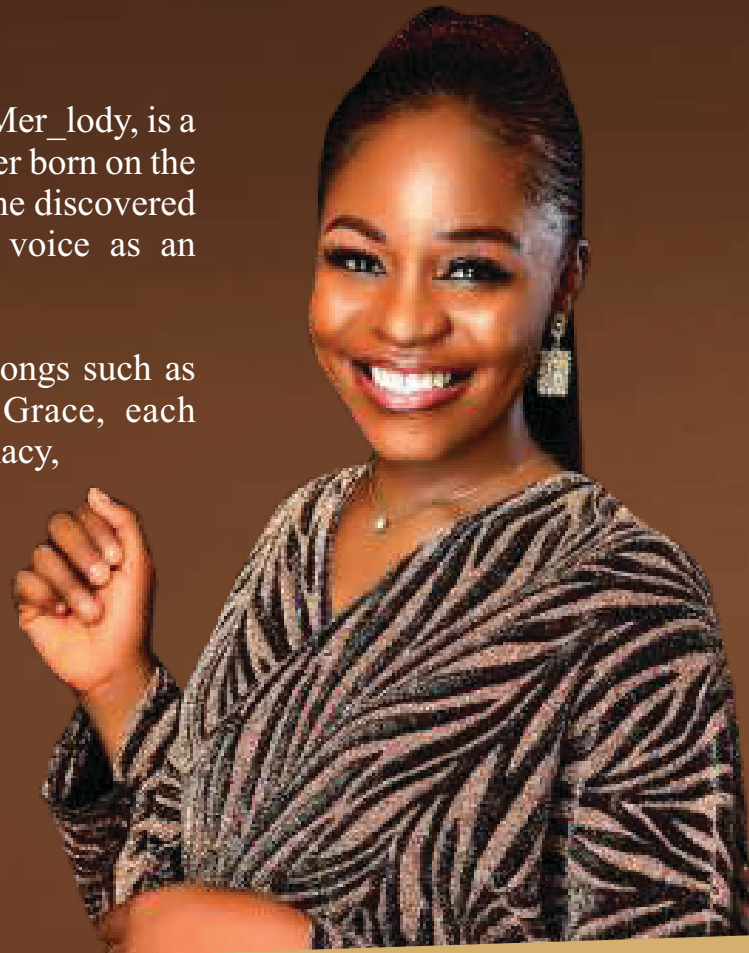


MER_LODY
